Scoring: This is a non-scoring, timed finals meet.

Entries: A.) Each team may enter a maximum of 4 swimmers per event

B.) Only one school relay per event is permissible.

C.) Swimmers may enter no more than 2 individual events and 2 relays **OR** 1 individual event and 3 relays.

Regulations: A.) Three coaches and two officials will act as a meet committee.

B.) Arrangements have been made to have USA Swimming Officials observe the meet.

Warm Ups: A.) Warm ups will begin at 9:30 a.m.

B.) Swimmers CANNOT enter the water until a lifeguard is on duty in the chair

C.) Starting blocks cannot be used until one-way sprint lanes are opened. Cones will be placed on the blocks and will be removed when sprint lanes are opened.

Awards:

- A.) Awards will be immediately after the final heat of each event. The top six places for each event will be awarded. The coach of the winning swimmer from each event will present the awards for that event. The presentation will take place on the starting blocks with 6th pace in lane 1 and 1st place in lane 6.
- B.) 1^{st} place will be awarded medals and 2^{nd} through 6^{th} place will be awarded ribbons
- C.) All Stars will be awarded a pin and certificate for 1st team and a certificate for 2nd and 3rd Team. Certificates will be given to the coaches blank so the names can be printed the way the coach wants them done.
